What is Google Classroom and the document suite?

Google Classroom is a free web service, developed by Google for schools, that aims to simplify creating, distributing, and grading assignments in a paperless way. The primary purpose of Google Classroom is to streamline the process of sharing files between teachers and students.

Google Classroom is an online or virtual classroom for your child.

- **Google Docs** is a word processor similar to Microsoft Word
- **Google Slides** is a presentation software similar to Microsoft PowerPoint
- **Google Sheets** is a Spreadsheet program similar to Microsoft Excel

How to access and join Google Classrooms

Signing in for the first time:

- Goto <https://classroom.google.com/> website and login.
 - ◆ Your username is: 20Surname.Initial@stcm.torbay.sch.uk which is the same as your network username.
 - ◆ If you have forgotten your password, email helpdesk@stcm.torbay.sch.uk with your name and request. Your password will be reset to **changeme** all lowercase, Helpdesk will reply to you on completion.


Joining a Class:

Every one of your teachers has set up a Google Classroom for you to be able to access your learning from home.

- Locate the classroom code from the 'STCM Online Learning' document, it will be a series of letters and numbers, it is case sensitive, for example 'mztvv3m'
- From the Google Classroom homepage click on the + sign in the top right corner and then Join Class.






Using Classroom
