Year 12

The VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy is a substantial vocational qualification for learners seeking a career as a junior beauty therapist. This qualification is designed for learners aged 16 years or over. This is a vocational qualification and includes all the required elements to work effectively as a junior therapist including, mandatory units covering the following: facial skincare, waxing, eyelash and eyebrow treatments, manicure, pedicure, client care and health and safety. You will also have the opportunity to further develop your understanding and skills by selecting a number of optional specialist units. The structure of this qualification provides you with the flexibility to develop your knowledge, understanding and skills required to become a junior beauty therapist.

Career opportunities exist in a variety of contexts as a junior beauty therapist, including:

- Working in commercial beauty salons
- Working in a retail concession in a department store
- Working independently/self-employed/mobile/home-based settings

Whilst this qualification's primary purpose is to prepare learners for employment as a junior beauty therapist learners may choose to develop their skills further by undertaking technical level qualifications in beauty therapy at Level 3.

They will need to be able to consult with their client, prepare and plan the treatment. They will also need to provide aftercare advice, including the avoidance of certain activities and the use of home care products. • This unit is about providing manicure and pedicure services to clients. You will learn about consulting with the client, recognising any contra-indications, preparing for the service, and producing a treatment plan. You will also learn about filing and buffing the nails, using skin and cuticle treatments, massaging the hand and feet, and using a suitable nail finish. You will need to carry out effective health, safety and hygienic working practices.
